WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

Our 2022 Yakima Valley Cab is sourced from four different vineyards, each chosen to showcase the best of Yakima Valley. Elephant Mountain provides the backbone of this wine, offering a plush mouthfeel and refreshing acidity. Red Willow, with its earthy tones and blueberry notes, adds depth, drawing from its James Beard-nominated reputation. At Two Blondes, known for its cool climate, delicate aromatics of lavender and florals grace the wine, while Ciel du Cheval, basking in Red Mountain's warmth, contributes bold tannins and vibrant cherry flavors.

TASTING NOTES:

Enticing aromas of ripe cherry mingle with subtle hints of licorice, gently accented by a touch of oak, promising a nuanced palate experience. On the palate, succulent flavors of ripe huckleberry take center stage, accompanied by refreshing notes of eucalyptus and a delicate hint of chocolate. Round tannins embrace the senses, imparting a velvety texture to the wine, while its light-to-medium body carries a satisfying weight.



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
