Drawn to its prime location within Red Mountain, renowned for producing exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon in Washington state, Justin was captivated by the meticulous farming practices and thoughtful approach to viticulture of Ciel du Cheval Vineyard. Moreover, Justin's fascination with Ciel du Cheval stems from its utilization of a novel grape clone within Washington state. Clone 337, originating from Bordeaux, was a recent addition to the vineyard's repertoire, adding a distinctive herbaceous quality and accentuating red fruit.

TASTING NOTES:

Delightful aromas of ripe cherry intertwine with subtle hints of cedar, accented by a touch of warming baking spice, inviting anticipation of the palate experience. The palate unfolds with luscious flavors of ripe blackberry and succulent cassis, accompanied by nuanced hints of tobacco, delivering a rich and layered tasting experience.
